CONTENT AREAS

Goal:

- •To explore the possibility of further expanding AP course offerings at Wahconah for the 2017-18 school year.
- •To analyze AP student performance data to inform instructional changes and address student needs
- •To actively seek out and enroll AP teachers is College Board certified training

Focus Areas:

1. Consult with Modern & Classical Languages department and AP Coordinator to explore the possibility of adding AP French and AP Spanish.

CONTENT AREAS

- 2. Consult with the Math & Business Tech department and AP Coordinator to explore the possibility of adding AP Computer Science.
- 3. Survey students to gauge interest in AP Spanish, French, and Computer Science.
- 4. Engage in the Collaborative Inquiry Protocol with all AP teachers in order to better inform instruction.
- 5. Work with appropriate Content Coordinators to assist AP teachers in locating and enrolling in College Board certified AP training.

Goal:

• To continue to identify remaining barriers and initiate improvement steps that increase access to general education for and inclusion of <u>all</u> students.

Focus Areas:

- 1. Work with Special Education teachers to identify remaining barriers to inclusive practices for all students.
- 2. Research resources that can help reduce remaining barriers (technological, instructional methodologies, Universal Design).
- 3. Work with liaisons and Special Services department to develop independence goals for students on IEPs.

- 5. Administration will provide continued support for Wahconah's new chapter of Best Buddies.
